Revelation 14:6 And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people,

Rev 14:7 Saying with a loud voice, <u>Fear God</u>, and <u>give glory to him</u>; for <u>the hour of his judgment</u> <u>is come</u>: and <u>worship him</u> that <u>made heaven</u>, and <u>earth</u>, and the <u>sea</u>, and the <u>fountains of waters</u>.

Revelation 14:8 And there followed another angel, saying, <u>Babylon</u> is <u>fallen</u>, is <u>fallen</u>, that great city, because she made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication.

Revelation 14:9 And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, <u>If any man worship</u> the <u>beast</u> and <u>his image</u>, and <u>receive his mark</u> in his forehead, or in his hand, Revelation 14:10: The same <u>shall drink</u> of the wine of the <u>wrath of God</u>, which is poured out <u>without mixture</u> into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be <u>tormented</u> with <u>fire</u> and <u>brimstone</u> in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb:

Revelation 18:2 And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, <u>Babylon</u> the great is <u>fallen</u>, is <u>fallen</u>, and is become the habitation of devils ...

Revelation 18:4 And I heard another voice from heaven, saying,

Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues.

Revelation 22:16 <u>I Jesus have sent mine angel</u> to testify unto you these things in the churches. <u>I am</u> the <u>root</u> and the <u>offspring</u> of <u>David</u>, and the <u>bright</u> and <u>morning star</u>.



- a. Jesus was born around Fall of 4-3 BC and then anointed/baptized at 30 years of age, **Luke 3:23**. Note that there are no year 0 in the calendar. So that 1 BC was immediately followed by AD 1.
- b. God teaches His view of days and years: 6 days or 6 years work, then a 7th day or 7th year rest, and a Jubilee year: **Genesis 1** and **2:1-4**; **Exodus 20:8-11**; **Exodus 21:2**; **Leviticus 25**.
- c. *Jubilee Year is the 50th year after 7 x 7 years, **Leviticus 25: 8, 10**. So $50 \times 40 = 2000$ years, and $40 \times 3 = 120$ Jubilee Years, "... his days shall be an hundred and twenty years.", **Genesis 6:3**.
